Emerald Class Update:

Emerald class have been learning about where food comes from over the last few weeks.

We started out with dairy products in Cornwall and today we looked at produce from all around the world!

The children created an enormous Earth jigsaw to support us with our journeys to far away places. Emeralds also learned a handy song to help remember the 7 continents.



Diamond Class Update:

The Diamond Class have been learning about Anna Atkins, who in 1854 created a series of images preserving nature using the cyanotype photographic process.

We used a similar process to create these botanical images using the grasses and plants in our local environment.

We were fascinated by the way the paper was initially bleached by the sun creating a negative space image, but once we placed it into the water, the colours reversed and 'set' leaving this beautiful Prussian blue design.



Year 4/5/6 Global Boarders Surf Day:

The Year 4,5 & 6 children had a fantastic day yesterday on Gwithian Beach learning to surf with the help of Global Boarders.
