It has been brought to our attention that one of the websites we use in school to teach coding has been subject to a security breach. This means that there is a risk of children viewing inappropriate material through this site.

The company are fully aware of this breach and are taking steps to rectify the situation. In school we have temporarily blocked live access until we can be completely confident that these issues have been resolved. Please can we ask you to be vigilant at home and discourage your child from using Scratch until further notice.
