# Crofty Trust Council King Edward Mine Visit:

Last Friday, Dexter and Layla were invited to visit the King Edward Mine Museum as representatives of the school and members of the Trust Council. They were joined by council members from all 16 Crofty schools. The children were working together exploring the impact of mining on the environment in the past and how the modern approaches to mining practice will prioritise sustainability and minimise ecological damage.
