Helston & Mullion Swimming Gala:

The school was delighted to send Y3/4 and Y5/6 teams to the area swimming gala on Tuesday morning, which took place at Helston Swimming Pool.

First up were the Y3/4s who had to swim 1 or 2 widths in front crawl, back stroke, breast stroke and even butterfly, along with some relays. This was followed by the Y5/6 races which were all 1 length (25m).

All of the children swam brilliantly and demonstrated fantastic team spirit and fair play throughout the entire competition.

Altogether, Godolphin achieved an impressive haul of **8 gold medals** for winning individual races, with all swimmers achieving excellent positions and scoring valuable points for the teams.
