

Today we celebrated the NSPCC Number Day with all the children taking part in lots of exciting mathematically themed activities. All pupils took part in seven different activities throughout the morning.

This included:

- Estimating, weighing and measuring potatoes and carrots
- Card games
- Identifying shapes
- Dice arithmetic
- Target throwing
- 3-D image art (tessellation)

The children had an amazing morning, practising lots of different mathematical concepts, with the key messages being 'maths is fun; it's everywhere and is for everyone'!
