The neurodiversity (ND) profiling tool is a visual document that assesses nine developmental strands of a child or young person aged 0-19. This includes speech and language, energy levels, attention skills, emotion regulation, sensory levels, motor skills, cognitive abilities, flexibility and adaptability, and empathy.
