The Zircons have enjoyed a busy week of mining adventures!

First up, on Tuesday, the class were treated to an informative and inspirational walk around the local area, including Godolphin Woods, Godolphin House, Godolphin Hill and Great Work Mine.

The tour was led by our very own intrepid and knowledgeable Governor – Steve Polglase – who was keen to share his passion and enthusiasm of the local history, particularly Godolphin's mining heritage.

At the end of the tour the children were invited back to Steve's house where he demonstrated aspects of the process of turning tin ore into tin concentrate ready to be smelted.

Huge thanks to Steve for once again for giving up his time.

On Thursday, the class ventured west where they visited Geevor Tin Mine, learning about the mine which remained open until 1990, as well as practically experiencing mining techniques from over 200 years ago.

The children were fascinated by the sheer scale and engineering of this incredible former working mine and were shown around by Geevor's expert and experienced guides who told real life stories of some of the miners.

We are very grateful to Cornish Metals for funding this trip, including the transport. And to Mrs Rogers and Mrs Gee for helping.
