Diamond Eden Project Visit:

The Diamond Class had a great visit to the Rainforest at the Eden Project last week. Having travelled on the new section of the A30 (very exciting!) we arrived and met Tom who told us all about Eden.

We then headed into the Rainforest biome. It was wonderful to see all the plants, trees and fruits that we had been learning about and also experience the heat and humidity of a tropical environment. From the canopy walk the children could clearly see the different layers of the rainforest, with a couple of emergents reaching up into the very top of the roof.

After lunch we headed into the core to investigate Blue; an immersive installation that pays homage to cyanobacteria, one of the world's smallest living beings. The sculpture is a monument to these vital microscopic beings, who, along with their descendants found in the photosynthesising cells of all green plants, continue to provide the oxygen in every breath we take. We enjoyed chasing the rings and anticipating where they would appear from next.

Before our walk back up to the Minibus, we popped to the Seed where we performed our rainforest storm body percussion – the acoustics were incredible there and we almost expected a lightning flash it was so realistic!

Thank you to all the children for being wonderful ambassadors for the school with their behaviour, interest and enthusiasm and to the staff for helping to make this trip so enjoyable.
