



- Thursday: Karaoke


Please book both Breakfast and After-School Club 48 hours in advance by contacting the school office. Payment for both will be made through ParentPay.

At 9am on Wednesday 16th Oct, Mrs Bowden is holding a phonics information meeting for all Reception parents/carers to provide details about how phonics is taught and the importance of supporting the learning at home.

Developmental Language Disorder Day: Friday 18th October:

Developmental Language Disorder (DLD) affects, on average, 2 children in every class of 30. Children with DLD have difficulty understanding what people say to them, and struggle to articulate their ideas and feelings.
