Maths Whizz

Congratulations to the children who reached the 'Hall of Fame' last week. Today the Maths Whizz trophy was presented once again to the Zircon Class.

We would like to encourage as many of our Y2-6 children to take advantage of this free maths resource by trying to achieve 3 blue and 3 red gems each week, enabling them to reach the Hall of Fame. Y1 pupils will be invited to use Maths Whizz later in the term.

One Minute Maths:

Don't forget, *pupils from Reception - Y6* can access *1-Minute Maths* to practice their fluency skills including subitising, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. The link can be found in Google Classrooms. The White Rose 1-Minute Maths app can also be downloaded free onto your own devices at home. Our Y1-6 children have been given 1-Minute Maths Fluency Passport which they can work through at their own pace at home and in school.

Zircon Class trip to CAST & Geography Field Work:

The Zircon class spent Monday morning at CAST in Helston exploring the history and science of colour. They also created their own paintings inspired by Greek myths using paints that they had produced from crushed charcoal and egg yolk!

In the afternoon, they conducted fieldwork linked to their geography topic of population. The children collected data on vehicles as well as finding out views on Helston as a place to live. An enjoyable but very wet afternoon!

Diamond Class trip to Truro Museum:

Last week the Diamond Class took part in an Ancient Egyptian Workshop at Truro Museum.

They began with an embalming session where the children took turns to remove the brain and then organs of a wealthy Egyptian, place them in the correct Canopic jar and then wrap the body in bandages. They then explored the gallery of artefacts and saw the mummified body of priest Iset -Tayef- Nakht and his reconstructed head. The children then searched in the sand for clues to artefacts including amulets, shabtis and a flint knife from the period.

Staff were delighted with the behaviour of the children, their enthusiasm for the activities and showing their knowledge through answering questions (an ideal opportunity for staff to assess their learning!!) Many thanks to Mrs Mason, Mrs Jones and Mrs Foden for volunteering their time - it is much appreciated, and to the staff for making this trip possible.
