Well done to all of our Y6s who received Bikeability cycling proficiency training this week.

The training develops skills for cycling on single-lane roads with simple junctions and moderate traffic, and includes the core functions for safe and responsible cycling.

In order to pass, the pupils had to make good and frequent observations; choose and maintain the most suitable riding positions; communicate intentions clearly to others; and understand priorities on the road, particularly at junctions.

All 16 of our Y6 pupils completed both Level 1 and 2. Well done to them all!
